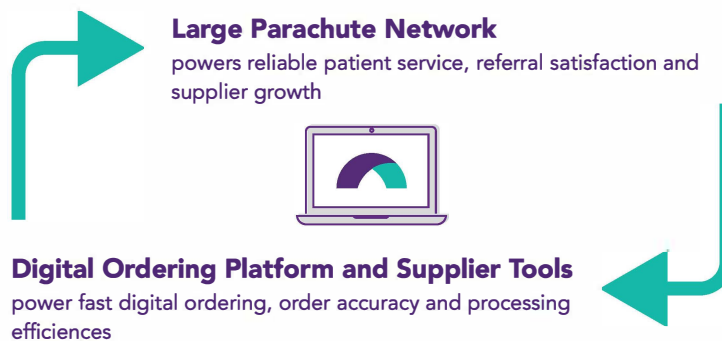

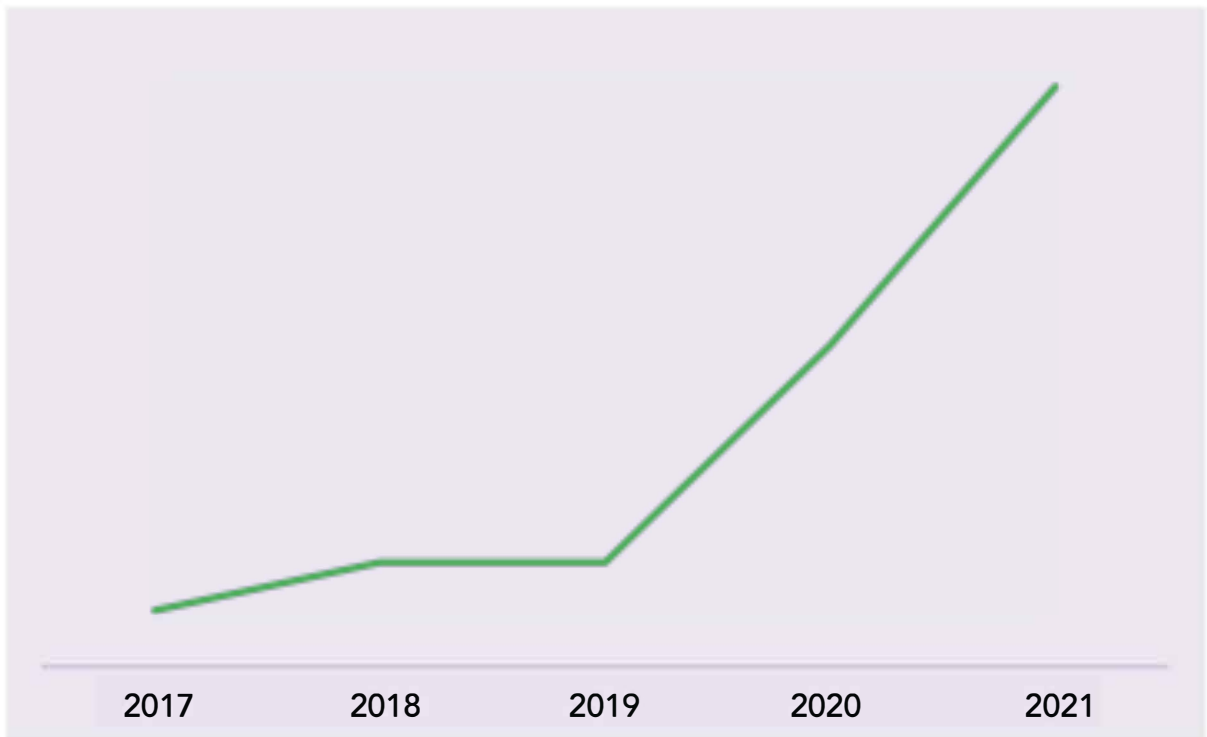

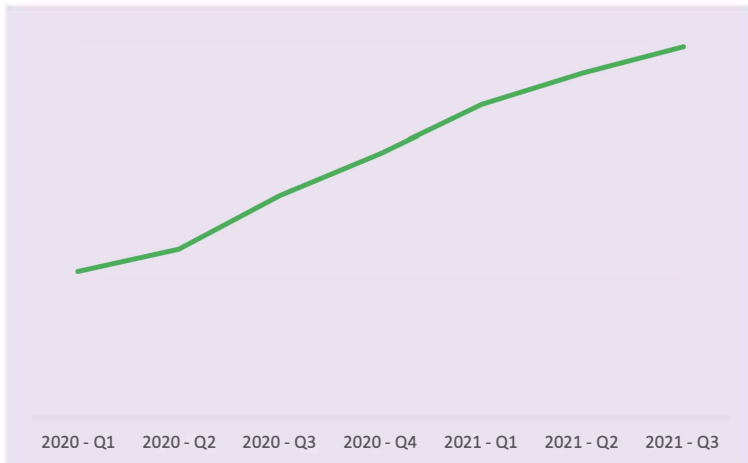
The Parachute Platform is **used by over 320,000 healthcare providers** — across ordering clinicians and signing MDs — continuing rapid growth since launch in 2016. The need for digital transformation and to move away from manual, in-person, and fax-based processes during the COVID-19 pandemic further accelerated adoption. We see this trend continuing, with month-to-month increases in 2021.

Annual growth in number of HCPCS ordered



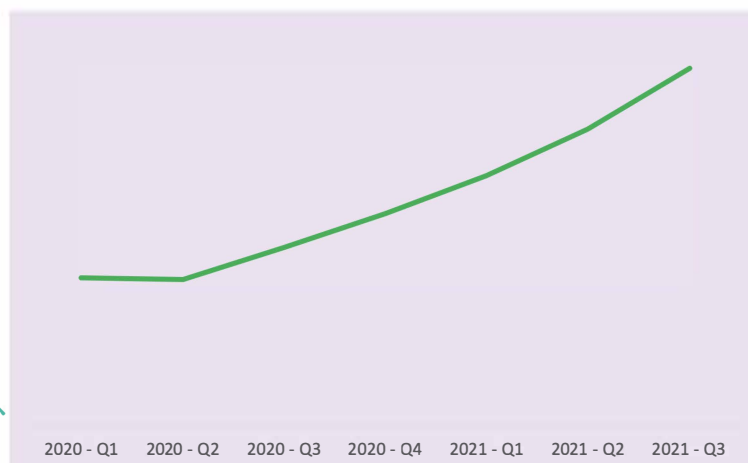


Rapid Adoption of DME ePrescribing

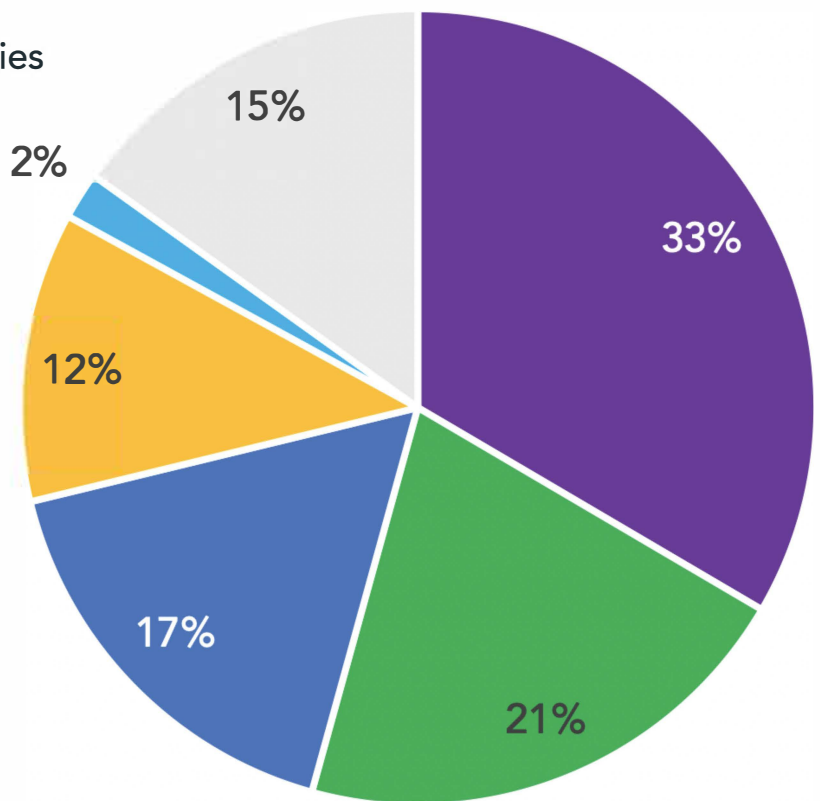
Non-MD clinicians appreciate the benefits of the Parachute Platform also, as the numbers show: **adoption increased 101% across all clinician types in the past year.**

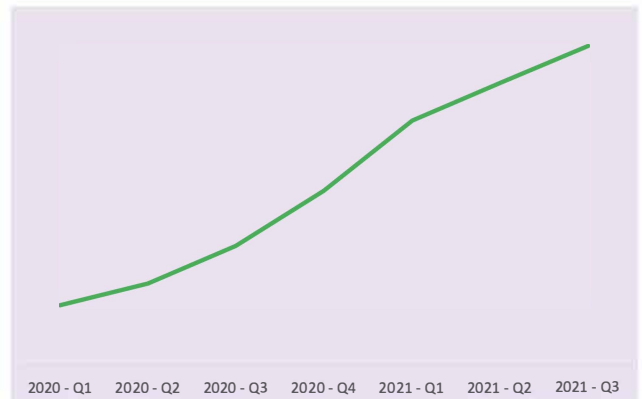

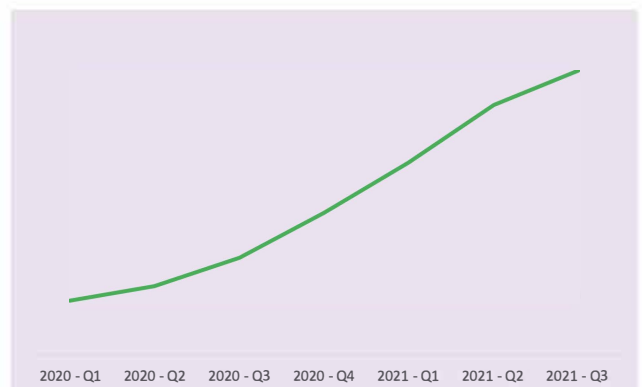

This shows up clearly in platform usage metrics: the number of hospitals that use DME ePrescribing has grown **165% this year ...**



...while the number of ambulatory practices that use DME ePrescribing has **nearly tripled**, with **191% growth in the same period.**

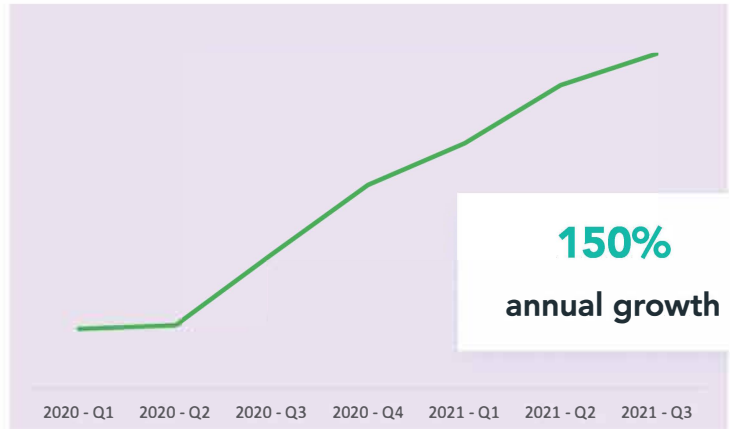

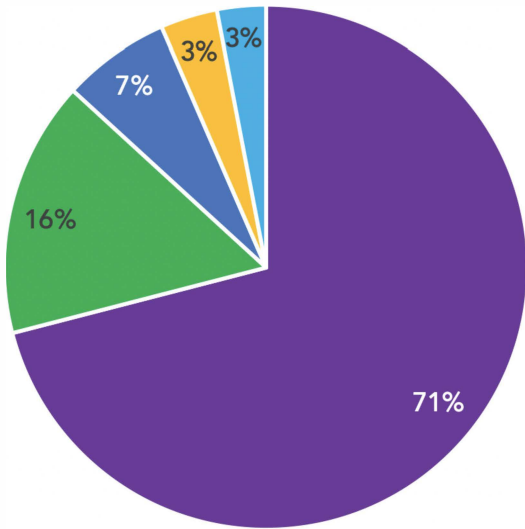

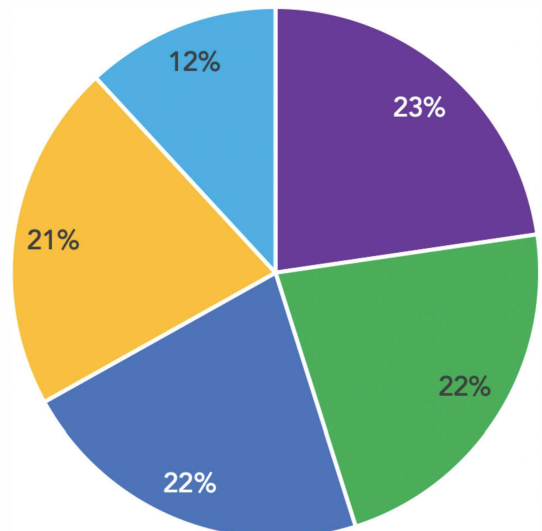

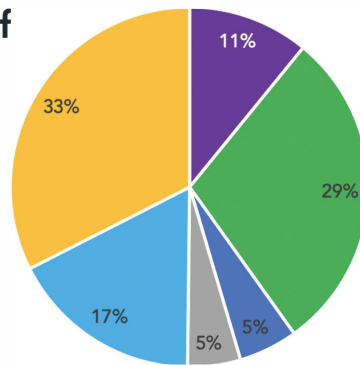

CASE STUDY

DME ePrescribing enabled the automation powering a Health Plan to reduce costs and achieve higher quality for its members

- 25% decrease in substantiated grievances, 20% reduction of inbound calls
- Tightly-integrated authorization and ordering improved claim payments from 65% to 90%

Establishing Industry Standards

In 2021, Parachute Health continued to work tirelessly with our network of providers and suppliers, as well as sit on the CMS Council for Document Requirement Lookup Service (DRLS) and the CMS Council for DME ePrescribing. Working with industry participants to define the standards we implement is crucial to our central goal: **to enable our provider and supplier partners** to focus on what they do best — **care for patients**.

The COVID-19 crisis was a stark reminder that healthcare must evolve. By eliminating the uncertainty and administrative inefficiency associated with DME order fulfillment, Parachute Health removes a major source of friction that historically held back the industry. Our goal is to end reliance on faxing, incomplete data, and disorganized workflows in DME ordering.

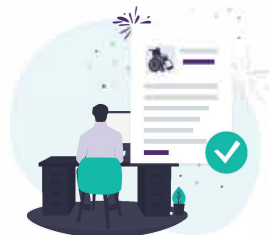

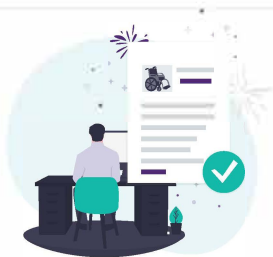

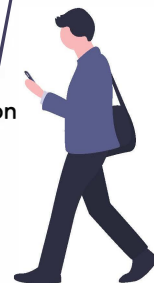
